

ICC Two-Day Tour

The Illawarra Cycle Club is proud to announce that it will be holding a Two Day Tour on July 17th and 18th. Racing will be held over four(possibly five) grades and will include men and women, including U15 juniors and older.

Event is sanctioned by CNSW as CAT4

The format of the tour is:

Saturday afternoon (2:00pm)

- 9km TT
- 27km scratch race

Sunday morning (8:30am)

- 67km scratch race (A, B & C grades)
- 44.5km scratch race (D grade)

The competitions within the event will be as follows:

- General Classification
- King of the mountains

General Classification (GC) will be the total accumulated race time less deductions for time bonuses. Time deductions will be given to the first riders across the line at Huntley each lap in the scratch races.

The King of the Mountains competition is based solely on the accumulated points awarded at the KOM on the top of Marshall Mount in Sunday morning's Scratch race.

All races will start at Huntley mine on Avondale road and use the usual race course along Avondale road, Huntley road and Marshall Mount road. The best viewing of the race will be on Sunday at the top of Marshall Mount hill.

Entry fee for the two days - \$40

Prize money - \$1,000 minimum

Entries limited to 120 riders, open to Illawarra riders only up to June 20th, then open to non Club members.

Entry fees to be collected by the club and paid to ICC in lump sum on the day(17th)

D&D Traffic Management will be performing the marshalling duties.
